TERMS & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- Entry to this competition is free.
- Entry is open to all children who reside on Phillip Island or San Remo, or attend a Primary School on Phillip Island or San Remo, from Prep to Grade 6. This year we also have two extra categories for students of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Island descent and students with special needs who reside the region.
- Entries close **5pm, 30 April 2024**, AEDT.
- Entries **MUST** be **A3** in size (or **A4** and we can double it). Please note only **scanned digital entries** are being accepted this year.
- Entries will be judged by Phillip Island Nature Parks staff. Posters will be judged against the theme of the Poster Competition and the criteria outlined on the provided competition information document.
- Winners will be announced on 22 May 2024.
- There will be one prize in each category to be won in this competition: the winner will receive a one Family 3 Park Pass to Phillip Island Nature parks (for two adults and two children including Penguin Parade General Viewing).
- Prizes cannot be transferred, upgraded or exchanged for cash.
- Phillip Island Nature Parks will collect personal information about you so that your child can participate, and we can administer the competition. We may use any personal information that an entrant has provided for the purpose of running the Competition, and in advertisements, publications, media statements and other promotional material associated with the Competition.
- By submitting the entry form, you give Phillip Island Nature Parks permission to publish the entrants first name, school, and age category on its website, in the local newspapers and on its social media channels if the entry is a winning entry.
- By submitting the entry form, entrants will assign a limited copyright of the artwork to the Phillip Island Nature Parks, enabling reproduction of the artwork for public displays and publications (both printed and digital) in conjunction with the competition AND for the purpose of publication in printed and digital material promoting Sharing Our Shores campaigns in subsequent years. Artists will be credited whenever the posters are used.
- Entries from students under the age of 18 must have adult consent. By ticking the above box, you acknowledge you have read and accept these terms and conditions.
